

The second finalist of Czech Jazz Contest 2015 become polish Weezdob Collective!

International competition for young jazz bands and soloists to the age of thirty Czech Jazz Contest 2015 has its second finalist! Quintet Weezdob Collective confirmed that polish jazz has a high level.

The Tuesday's and Wednesday's evening belonged the stage of the legendary Reduta Jazz Club to young musical talents again. It was held the second semifinal round of competition Czech Jazz Contest 2015, where two german bands Bodosapiens and Der Weise Panda, Weezdob Collective and hungarian Balogh Tamás Quartet clashed. The audience enjoyed original and energetic approaches to jazz, in which can be heard fresh elements of R&B, classical and contemporary music for both evenings. Each of the competing bands showcased an unique show and created an electrifying atmosphere in the club.

The jury sent polish Weezdob Collective to the final. The ensemble gained jury by not only great improvisational abilities of the individual instrumentalists and precision and imaginative arrangements, but also original and compact sound and energy. So you can look forward to a duel between two Polish bands in the final round! Who will be another finalist? This will be decided in the third semifinal round next week, which Slovakian project Quintet at Dawn, Silence Fiction from Hungary and polish Sound of Affection and Derlak-Trąbczyński-Szablowski Trio will compete.

During Czech Jazz Contest 2015 is also prepared accompanying concerts, jam sessions and educational workshops, which will take part not only the leading personalities of Czech jazz as Milan Svoboda, Ondřej Štveráček and others, but the stars of the world music scene Vincent Herring and Gene Jackson. Each semifinal round is conducted by competition for audience and especially for students are prepared discounts not only on admission, but also at the bar!
